  - During lockdown the Peak District National Park has been restructured
  - Disappointed with the Country File programme on 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary programme which did not feature the Chief Executive or Chair. 260 empty barns which should spur the councils into action
  - Anthony Crook - Attended local plan review in another capacity and there was a long discussion about housing. More need to address affordable housing but also need to look at key workers as well as family connections.

- Insurance is due this month and so needs to be incorporated into the Parish Council insurance. It was agreed the Clerk will look into this. Dean Hill has taken over the strimming of the burial ground and he is meeting the committee on 16<sup>th</sup> June. It was agreed to allow him to mow the area for 18 months and then bring all the mowing contracts into one ground maintenance contract at the end of 2022.
